- 2. Capturable value per ton. To start with, we have considered the average over 2004-05 till 2011-12, viz. Rs. 1,909 per ton
- 3. Extraction rate tons per annum. This is in the lower table. 20 mn is the current cap. 50 million is near the peak exports. 1 mn gives a simple rule of thumb
- 4. Capture rate %. Historical has been around 4.4%. With the Supreme Court permanent fund, this rises to 20.7%. Our target is 90%
- 5. Investment rate. What proportion of the amount captured is invested. The sheet assumes 100% investment into the GMPF.
- 6. Real interest rate earned this has been taken as 3%. Note that this hs to be earned over and above inflation, and after all taxes and expenses. Not trivial.
- 7. The population has been taken constant at the Census 2011 level of 14,57,723. Since the decadal population growth rate has declined sharply from 16% to 8%, it is possible that the population will stabilise at 2011 levels.
